## Glossary of ornaments described in notes

**Bandeau (Headpiece)**: horizontal ornament, sometimes framed, printed above the title at the beginning of a text or at the beginning of a section of a text, either decorated (vegetal motifs, coat of arms), historiated (scene) or composed of the juxtaposition of the same fleuron or of the combination of several fleurons (frieze).

**Cul-de-lampe**: triangular ornament pointing downward composed of architectural and decorative motives or of the same repeated fleuron.

Please note that 'cul-de-lampe' is also used in French to describe a tailpiece, that is the ornament printed at the end of a text, a chapter or a section of a text. The decoration of this type of ornament is also described in the database.

**Fleuron**: vegetal, naturalist, or stylized ornament printed on the titlepage, at the end of the text or between parts of the text (stanza for texts in verse).

**Lettre initiale ornée (decorated initial)**: initial letter composed of simple, usually vegetal, decoration.

**Lettre initiale historiée (Historiated initial)** : initial letter containing a scene.

**Marque décorative (Decorative mark)**: ornament, other than 'vignette' or coat of arms, printed on the title-page, that does not identify the printer. Its decoration is described. It can be a 'cul-de-lampe'.

**Marque typographique (Printer's device)** : ornament identifying the printer (trademark).

**Vignette**: framed ornament. The decoration is described.
